ALL POLYESTER POWDER COATED & PVC SECTIONS, POLISHED METAL AND LAMINATE FACINGS

Cleaning: Abrasive cleaners should not be used.

An occasional wipe using a mild detergent solution, rinse with a clean damp Cloth (avoid over - wetting), and

then buff with a clean dry cloth.

Cleaning liquids should be wiped away completely or staining may appear on adjacent surfaces.

Repair: Superficial damage – painted items can be re-painted with touch up paint, Other items no treatment possible.

Substantial damage – replace component.

WALL PANEL FACINGS

Cleaning: See manufacturers instruction for individual types. Some fabric materials may shrink if liquid cleaners are used.

Repair: Superficial damage – painted surfaces should be filled with appropriate filler, sanded smooth and repainted. Vinyl

finishes should be filled as above and re-fix or patch vinyl with a PVA based adhesive.

Substantial damage – replace component.

GLASS SURFACES

Cleaning: Use proprietary glass cleaner for any glass surface, avoid abrasive materials, and avoid excessive amounts of

water. Use a clean, dry, lint-free soft cloth, water and a mild detergent.

Cleaning liquids should be wiped away completely or staining may appear on adjacent surfaces.

Repair: Superficial damage – no repair possible.

Substantial damage - replace component.

MOVING PARTS

Cleaning: Prior to installing glazing, the inside of the tracks should be brushed or wiped clean.

Maintenance: Door Hinges, Inspect, adjust if necessary and lubricate every six months or more frequently in a dry area. Lock

mechanisms should be lightly oiled during use as required with excess lubricant wiped away. Door closers, inspect, adjust if necessary to prevent slamming or ensure correct closing and lubricate every six months or more frequently in a dry area. Do not wedge in an open position, as this can damage the seals and cause oil leakage.

In fire rated constructions, this practice would contravene the fire regulations.

Repair: Damage to hinges, lock mechanisms, ironmongery or door closers will necessitate replacement.

ELECTRICAL

Care should be taken when cleaning with liquids in close proximity to electrical switchgear or outlets to avoid contact. Servicing should only be carried out by a qualified electrician.
